EITC Blessing



The Pre-K EITC program provides financial assistance through scholarships to families in need that are currently enrolled in early education programs. Many of the families that have received assistance from these donations would not otherwise be able to afford preschool education for their children.

This program is such a "win-win" situation!! The company that donates the funds is able to receive up to a 100% tax credit for the amount donated, and Hilltop receives the funds it needs to be able to support families in our community.

Many local businesses would be able to be a part of this very simple process!! If the business is paying any of the following taxes: Corporate Net Income Tax, Capital Stock Franchise Tax, Bank and Trust Company Shares Tax, Title Insurance Companies Shares Tax, Insurance Premiums Tax, or Mutual Thrift Institutions Tax, their business can qualify. In many cases, the same amount that a business is paying in taxes can be sent to us at Hilltop!!!
