SPECIAL DAYS

We have some fun and special days planned this month. Be sure to check your child's calendar to see what is happening in each classroom. To give the children a chance to share some of their Christmas treasures, we have show-and-share days. Some classes will have Snowflake Day. Feel free to wear a snowflake outfit or bring your favorite homemade snowflake from home. We'll use this time to look at how God made each snowflake unique just the way He has made each of us. The 4 & 5 year olds will have a Pajama Party Day as well. Feel free to send your child to school in their pajamas. It is a fun day!



THEMES

The themes for the 2's are Winter and Snow. They will be working on beginning to understand that other's have feelings; imitating adult actions; and participating willingly in simple games and activities. Their Bible verse is Psalm 147:16, "God spreads the snow."

The themes for the 3's are Winter and Snow. They will be working on transitioning easily; participating willingly; completing puzzles; recognition of shapes (circle, square, and triangle), and listening intently to stories. Their Bible verse is Psalm 147:16, "God spreads the snow and scatters the frost."

The themes for the 4's are Jesus Grew and So Do We; Winter; and Snow. They will be working on speaking in front of a group of peers; listening while others speak; cutting a straight line; distinguishing between small, smaller, smallest; and identifying same and different. Their verse is Luke 2:52, "And Jesus grew both tall and wise."

The theme for the 5's is Weathering the Weather. They will be working on building strong relationships with others in the class; answering questions appropriately; tracing numbers 1-20; tracing basic shapes; weather terms; experimenting with the three forms of matter; time concepts; Letters R-Z; and being responsible. Their Bible verse is Romans 10:9, "That if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved."

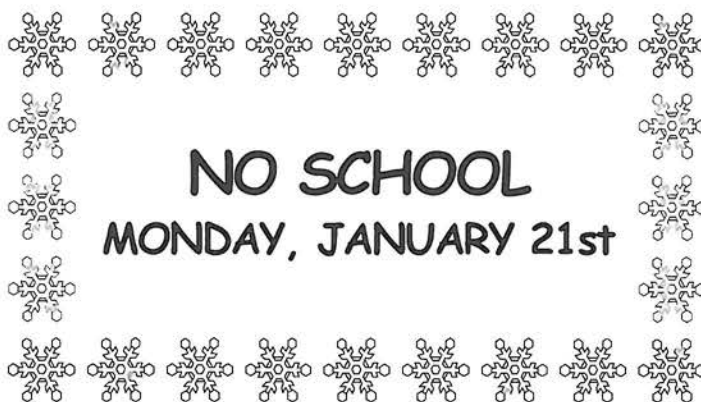


LIBRARY CART
